## **GENERAL PROGRAM FUNDING INFORMATION**

**About the Foundation:** The Marty Wilson Jr. Art & Music Foundation (MWAMF), a 501(c)3 non-profit organization, provides financial funding and sponsorship for approved programs and/or projects which educate local youth in art and music. Eligibility criteria: Anyone who works directly with students in the Atlantic County/Greater Atlantic City area is eligible to apply for program or project funding. MWAMF will entertain support of any project or program that educates youth in the areas of art or music. Priority is given to afterschool programs however, no exclusions apply in regard to integrated school day programs, weekend or summer activities. Programs/projects which encourage, enhance, and/or educate youth in the arts and music will be considered for funding. This includes but is not limited to painting, mural arts, graphic design, crafting, sculpting, pottery, sketching, dance, music appreciation, poetry, literary club/magazine, musical instrument instruction, photography, band, choir, glee club, theatre, performing and related arts.

**Funding Requirements:** Funding periods vary depending on the project or program. Requests are considered throughout the calendar year. If the program is a school year based one, it is necessary to submit an application prior to the start of that period. Documentation of all expenditures and participation records must be submitted to MWAMF as specified in each individual agreement/contract. Applicable teacher's stipends will be paid retrospectively as soon after reports of hours worked are submitted.
